



Sixth Form Uniform and Dress Code

The uniform in sixth form is **business wear**. Students are expected to look smart and professional, to prepare them for the workplace.

Students can either wear:

Suit or smart jacket and trousers
Collared shirt
Tie
Black or brown smart shoes

Or:

Suit or smart jacket with trousers / skirt and tights
Shirt or smart top
Black or brown smart shoes

Dress Code

Coats are not to be worn instead of smart jackets around school
Jumpers must be smart, and are not to be worn instead of a shirt or smart top (girls)
Skirts must be an appropriate length for the workplace
Hair styles, jewellery, and accessories must be appropriate for the workplace

The following items are not acceptable uniform:

Leather/denim jackets and clothing
Mini skirts (pleated or tight)
Hoodies
Knee length boots
UGGs
Trainers
Cropped clothing
Vest tops
